

GENERAL PRIVACY POLICY FOR THE USE OF THE KOZERDEKES.ORG WEBSITE

WEBSITE DATA MANAGEMENT

The kozerdekes.org website is operated by Közérdekes.

DATA MANAGER

WHAT DATA DO WE MANAGE?

When viewing the website, due to technical operation, we automatically record the start and end times of the visit, and in some cases - depending on the computer settings - the browser, operating system data and IP address, as well as the name and URL of the page from which the visitor arrives at our website. From this data, the system can generate actual statistical data. We do not link this data with other personal data and use it solely for statistical purposes. The kozerdekes.org may send cookies to visitors' computers. The cookies are necessary, among other things, to display automatic messages to users. Cookies are not used by Közérdekes for commercial purposes, but can be used to promote donations through remarketing tools (Google tracking code, Facebook pixel, TikTok pixel, Barion pixel).

When using the contact form, subscribing to the newsletter and contacting us, the user's name, address, telephone number and e-mail address may be used for the purpose of maintaining contact with Közérdekes. In the case of newsletter subscribers, we treat the fact of opening individual letters and their interests related to the organization's activities as personal data. Közérdekes does not make these data available to other visitors of the website.

If someone supports Közérdekes with a donation, whether via PayPal or another payment method, Közérdekes may process the name of the supporter, bank account number, the amount of the support, and the time of its receipt.

In addition Közérdekes also produces and publishes content on its website and social media platforms. Our activities are closely related to the practice of freedom of speech, and we can also report on public affairs. In addition, the purpose of content production and communication is to promote the goals of Közérdekes, the organization, and to recruit supporters for these goals and the organization. As part of its content production activities, Közérdekes manages the data of all natural persons who contributed to the production of the content as sources or to whom the content refers. The personal data processed in content production cannot be determined in advance, as we cannot know what we will report on in the future. Typically, during this activity, we process the following

data: the name, position, workplace, age, place of residence of the data subject, and other data indicating how the data subject relates to the topic of the edited content. The Data Manager processes special personal data if the data subject has given their explicit consent, or if the data subject has explicitly made them public, or if the processing is necessary for reasons of substantial public interest based on European Union law or Member State law and is proportionate to the purpose sought.

LEGAL BASIS OF THE DATA MANAGEMENT

The management of personal data through the use of the website, as well as all other data provided by the user, takes place with the user's voluntary consent, in accordance with this information.

During our content production and publishing activities, the legal basis for data processing is, on the one hand, the consent of those appearing in the content, for example those who make statements to us [GDPR Article 6 (1) a)]. In other cases, when we report of public figures in the context of public affairs, the legal basis for our processing is the public interest of our activities [GDPR Article 6(1)(e)]. Közérdekes deals with fundamental rights, constitutional, democratic and rule of law issues, in relation to which it provides knowledge transmission. Közérdekes is a non-profit organization and does not conduct business activities. The goals of the Közérdekes organization include the protection of fundamental human rights and the rule of law guarantees, part of which is the communication of relevant content related to the above to society.

TYPES OF MANAGED DATA

With the exception of the purposes indicated in point 1.), which apply to all site visitors, the purposes listed in the other points are only achieved if the visitor voluntarily provides your data for the purposes indicated in points 2-7.).

1. **Website visitor data** – The recording and storage of the time of visit, IP address, and browser and operating system data is a feature of the system's operation, and their processing is technically essential and is carried out exclusively for statistical purposes.
2. **Newsletter subscription** – The purpose of processing personal data provided to Közérdekes is to enable the data subject to request a newsletter and for the Közérdekes organization to send them a newsletter. The processing of personal data and the provision of the newsletter service are for the purpose of communicating with the data subject in this regard. Közérdekes does not use personal data for any other purpose and treats it confidentially. The option to unsubscribe from the newsletter can be accessed by clicking on the 'Unsubscribe' link located after the privacy policy in the newsletter's footer, which will navigate the user to the unsubscribe page, where the user can do so by entering their email address and then clicking the unsubscribe button.
3. **Petition** – The purpose of processing personal data provided to Közérdekes is to enable the data subject to support the cause initiated by Közérdekes by providing

their data, and Közérdekes to send them information regarding the results of the signature collection and the details of the cause. Personal data is processed solely for the purpose of communicating with the data subject in this regard. Közérdekes does not use personal data for any other purpose and treats it confidentially. The data subject may also unsubscribe from information letters. The option to unsubscribe from the letter can be accessed by clicking on the 'Unsubscribe' link located after the privacy policy in the letter's footer, which will navigate the user to the unsubscribe page, where the user can do so by entering their email address and then clicking on the unsubscribe button.

4. **Event registration** – The purpose of processing personal data provided to Közérdekes is to enable the data subject to indicate their intention to participate in the event organized by Közérdekes by providing their data, and for Közérdekes to send them information regarding the details of the event. Personal data is processed solely for the purpose of communicating with the data subject in this regard. Közérdekes does not use personal data for any other purpose and treats it confidentially. The data subject may also unsubscribe from information letters. The option to unsubscribe from the letter can be accessed by clicking on the 'Unsubscribe' link located after the privacy policy in the letter's footer, which will navigate the user to the unsubscribe page, where the user can do so by entering their email address and then clicking on the unsubscribe button.
5. **Donation** – The purpose of processing personal data provided to Közérdekes is for the data manager (Közérdekes) to guarantee communication between the service provider and the data subject in order to ensure the smooth provision of the service. Personal data is not used by Közérdekes for any other purpose and is treated confidentially. The donation terms and conditions can be found in the Donation Terms and Conditions document.
6. **Donation Shop** – The purpose of processing personal data provided to Közérdekes is for the data manager (Közérdekes) to ensure the smooth provision of the service and the communication between the service provider and the data subject, as well as the conditions for the delivery of the items chosen in exchange for the donation, in order to ensure the smooth provision of the service and maintain contact with the donor. The personal data provided during the donation (name, email address, shipping address, phone number) will not be used by the Közérdekes organization for any other purpose. In the case of home delivery, the personal data necessary for delivery will be forwarded to the selected shipping company. When donating in the donation shop (kozerdekes.org/donationshop), the user can enter the desired details of the item(s) chosen in exchange for their donation on the interface of the built-in webshop module.
7. **7. Questionnaire and contact form** – The purpose of processing personal data provided to Közérdekes is for Közérdekes to assess the needs and opinions of users filling out the questionnaire regarding the organization's activities. Based on the answers given in the questionnaire(s), Közérdekes organizes events and

possibly transforms some of its activities. If the data subject provides their e-mail address and/or telephone number, Közérdekes may notify them of events or activities corresponding to the topic of their answers, and Közérdekes may send them information in this context. Közérdekes does not use personal data for any other purpose and treats it confidentially.

The above-mentioned data may be used for aggregated statistical purposes. The data manager does not process personal data for purposes other than those specified. The processing of the provided data is carried out with the user's voluntary consent.

Within the framework of content production and publication activities, the purpose of data processing is to provide information and reporting on general knowledge concerning fundamental rights, constitutional, democratic rule of law, educational issues and public affairs, to initiate and conduct dialogue and debate on public affairs related to fundamental rights, constitutional, democratic rule of law and educational issues, as well as to promote the goals of Közérdekes and the organization, and to recruit supporters. Közérdekes only manages personal data to which the data subjects have given their consent, or the data is closely related to a public matter and is necessary for authentic and accurate information about the given public matter.

DURATION OF DATA MANAGEMENT

Session IDs are automatically deleted when the browser is closed. The user can delete their own cookies at any time. Cookies may be deleted automatically depending on the browser settings. If the user has consented to the use of their data for the purposes specified in the Types of managed data section, this data will be stored until they provide otherwise/withdraw their consent.

In connection with content production and publishing activities, Közérdekes manages personal data to the extent and for the period necessary to achieve the public affairs purpose.

DATA ACCESSORS, DATA MANAGERS

Only those employees of the data managers whose work justifies this may have access to the personal data provided by users, as well as to data automatically obtained due to technical operation.

The data of kozerdekes.org is stored on Webnode servers. Webnode also has access to the generated data as a data processor, which maintains its server in Switzerland (Webnode AG, identification number CH - 170.3.036.124-0, registered office Badenerstrasse 47, 8004 Zurich, Switzerland). Webnode's Privacy Policy is available at the following link: <https://www.webnode.com/hu/privacy-policy/>.

The data manager does not transfer personal data to third parties, except if the user has provided their personal data for such a purpose.

In the case of mandatory data transfers prescribed by law, Közérdekes examines each data item before fulfilling each official data request to determine whether the legal basis

for the data transfer actually exists and, if necessary, requests the opinion of the data protection authority. The user has the right to modify the provided data at any time. In case of intention to subscribe to the newsletter with a modified mailing address, at first must unsubscribe from the old email address and then subscribe with the new email address. The data subject's email address is not public and is not accessible to third parties. Közérdekes' employees have access to personal data when editing the content. In the case of published content, the public also has access to the data to which the data subject has consented or whose publication is necessary and proportionate for the provision of appropriate information in public affairs.

RIGHTS OF DATA SUBJECTS RELATED TO THE PROCESSING OF THEIR PERSONAL DATA

Access

Any data subject may request information about the processing of their personal data. At the request of the data subject, the data manager shall provide the data subject with written information within 25 days about the data it manages, the purpose, legal basis, duration of the data managing, the name, address (registered office) of the data processor and its activities related to the data processing, as well as who receives or has received the data and for what purpose. We can ensure these rights of the data subject after prior identification, verification of the data subject's identity is required. Correction,deletion

Data subjects may request in writing the modification and deletion of their personal data (or part of it). The data manager will respond to these requests as soon as possible, but no later than within three weeks. Deletion is possible if the data subject withdraws their consent, which is the basis for data management, and there is no other legal basis for the management

Objection

Users may object to the processing of their personal data, and may request the correction and deletion of their personal data at the data controller's mailing address (Jókai Mór utca 1.,Perkáta, 2431 Hungary; assistance@kozerdekes.org).

Data portability

Data subjects may request the provision of personal data they have provided to the data manager. The data may be requested in writing, in paper or machine-readable format.

The data manager will make this available to the data subject within 25 days of the request.

ENFORCEMENT OPTIONS

We ask users that if they feel that Közérdekes has violated their right to the protection of personal data, they should contact us so that we can remedy any possible violation. We inform users that they can also assert their claims before a civil court or request the assistance of the data protection authority. Detailed legal provisions on this and the obligations of the data controller are set out in Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Regulation (EC) No 95/46. (April 27, 2016), Act CXII of 2011 on the right to informational self-determination and freedom of information, and Act CVIII of 2001 on certain issues of electronic commerce services and services related to the information society, Section 13/A. Közérdekes processes your personal data only in accordance with this privacy policy and applicable data protection laws. However, if you still wish to make a complaint about the processing of your personal data or are otherwise dissatisfied with the way we handle your data, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority.

Judicial proceedings: the adjudication of data protection lawsuits falls within the jurisdiction of the court. The lawsuit may also be initiated before the court of the data subject's domicile or place of residence, at the data subject's choice.

CLAUSE

The data manager reserves the right to change its data protection declaration. This may occur in particular if the range of services is expanded or if it is required by law. The data manager will publish the relevant information on its website 15 days in advance. The change in data management can not mean that personal data is processed for a different purpose.
